Finally, we are at home. Three days after returning from America, we joined a group of friends and enjoyed spiritual sharing and mutual encouragement. This month began with another mountain retreat, this time with our church. This was more like a family retreat. We had quite a few children of all ages. Morning and evening messages were focused on Stewardship. We had two pastors from the church in Spokane, another American pastor, and a church planter from Pilsen. Living and being here for 5 years his Czech language was excellent, although it takes a lot of effort and commitment.

Our congregation is very diverse. It is multigenerational and truly international -Czechs, Americans, Armenians, Romanians, Moldovans, and Ukrainians; we are in close contact with Polish-speaking believers, for almost half of them Czech is not their mother tongue. We have white-collar, and blue-collar people, technicians of all kinds, military, advocates, truck and delivery drivers, and teachers ... One thing we have in common, the circle of our families, friends, neighbors, and co-workers are all non-believers. We were away for two months and it is time to start again. For the remnant of July and August, we will stay more or less at home and continue with our project.
