Dear friends,

Our apology to all of you we communicate with by e-mail. Our January printed Prayer letter got out but electronic version was delayed. We mentioned in our last e-mail that we had a major crash of our server and we tried to restore some services across two

continents and three countries. In the meantime we were using emergency measures to function. Providently we did not loose any data. This server PC was a trouble maker for some time (especially when Pavel left house). As you know we are in Arizona to take care of Pavel's medical issue. Since our last communication Pavel had a BPH biopsy done. Tuesday March 9th he has another doctor's appointment and will know what will be the next step. Between doctor's appointment and church visits we are like a road runners. So far we visited our churches and individuals in Flagstaff, Tucson and Phoenix. It is great to be surrounded by love and prayers. Thank you to all for being such encouragement to us. Here is what we prepared for you before we left Czech Republic:

Great start 2010

Winter theology conference: We had about 45 attendees; one man arrived from Germany to spend a day with us. Our friendship goes back to our time in Quito (1990). Conference covered five topics, all dealing with different angles of the church. Recording will be available on MP3 and hopefully also in print as No. 4 of pocket theology series. We rejoice that our desire to serve the Lord can be multiplied. Program translations: In His time we discovered that Czech / Slovak Google translator works fantastic. Since both languages are similar, accuracy is about 95%.

Publishing ministry: We launched new series of pocket sermons. First 80 pages booklet is Spurgeon's, Faith's Dawn and its Clouds. The translations are in their personal possessions as pastoral family heritage.

New Bible translations: we informed you about previous translation into modern Czech. Finally we have Study Bible translations available.

Our immediate plans: February 14th we flew via London to Phoenix, AZ for 6 weeks. We will combine Home ministry and Pavel's health consultation. We hope that during this time we can reconnect with our supporting churches and friends in the area and attend part of Mission conferences. We are not sure if we will see the kids and grandkids.
