LORD IS SO GOOD

The last four days of April Klara spent at Croatia Thrive Retreat in a beautiful hotel in Dubrovnik (formerly Yugoslavia). This was the 52nd retreat and over 4000 missionaries were already served. She had a US sponsor, Marry Ellen, a longtime friend we have known from Indonesia for 30 years. What a joy to be with someone she liked, knew her children and kept in touch for all those years. There were ladies coming from 34 countries, serving with 56 mission organizations. From the U.S. came 38 volunteers to spoil about 90 attendees. Since the first moment we were cherished and pampered. About one third of ladies came from countries where Christians are not welcomed. In the morning we had a special speaker session. What struck Klara right at the beginning was that Anna Hampton spoke about Jesus prayer in John's 17th chapter: Appeal to intimacy; Petition of Unity in Action and Request for Protection in the Battle. Just before Klara departed for Dubrovnik she finished the regular monthly supply translated messages from Pastor Cole that are broadcast by Czech Radio 7 (TWR).

In the afternoon the attendees had options to sign up for pampering experience: pedicure, color analysis, massage, counselling, prayer, hair, health counselling, art, computer help, photo, and of course time to be and interact with ladies serving in different parts of the world – as far as in Indonesia or as close as Austria and Macedonia. We had young moms with little children as well as grandmas; those who just started their mission assignment as well as those who served many years in really hard places. It is hard to imagine living in a mud hut on the top of the hill, or to be covered from head to toe, not able to walk outside at all, or seeing evacuation, kidnapping or killing people next to you. One of the events was sharing a funny story or experience in the field. Those who shared their stories were laughing so much that they could hardly talk. Mostly it was about conquering a new language, cultural differences or intimate embarrassing moments while in very primitive places. Day by day our burdens, pains and problems were melting away. We were daily lavished

with small gifts, special packages of treats from the U.S. and gift exchanges. Klara was overjoyed to link with volunteers from places where we lived, CO, CA, AZ. Arizona volunteers were especially great girls; since Tucson is a relatively small town, and there were so many connections, happy memories and great friendships were recalled. The goal of the Thrive Ministry is to encourage and empower global women to thrive and to be their advocate. Klara must say that it was a lifetime experience.
