For those who stay around, this is the time to pick wild blueberries in the forest, pick sweet apricots from the garden and begin canning a winter supply of wonderful preserves. Our neighbor, whose balcony plants I care for during their summer absence, provides us with yummy creations.

As we stay at home, we welcome a number of visitors who stop in Prague on the way somewhere. Our favorite activity is to take them on a paddleboat ride on the river. Next, we stop to cool off with ice cream, have a cup of coffee and catch up on what is going on in their life. We usually spend a few days or a week with fellow Christians at a mountain retreat.
