As for our region, we are excited that a number of Czech and Slovak Christians are involved in various ministries and they know best what is needed and how to do it. We feel that His Kingdom is not diminishing and nationals are raised up and trained to serve. Our prayer is that all ministries in Regions done by international partners will be sensitive to the work of local Christians.

CONFERENCE CONCLUSION AND RESPONSE

We have to be ready to face changes in the ministries and our lives. May God help us being obedient and walking in faith. Nothing is impossible for God. We should fully trust Him. Only He knows, and only eternity will reveal the true results of all the work done.

MINISTRY SITUATION AND CHANGES

Please pray for encouragement of Slovak servants.

Our magazine translator and editor are not able to do their work on time or at all, due to difficult family situation. For this reason we decided that as of the next year we will mail to Slovak readers only the Czech version of the magazine. Please pray that the language change will not affect Slovak readership.
