DEAR FRIENDS AND PARTNERS OF THE REACH BEYOND MINISTRY TO THE PEOPLES IN CZECH REPUBLIC AND SLOVAKIA

We are quickly approaching the end of another year of blessings with expectation what the next year will bring to all of us as individuals, families, countries and whole



world. As we look back on the year which just has passed we stand in awe to see so many unexpected changes. One of the greater one was the presidential election. It will be next January for one president the last day, for the new one the first day in the office.

WE NEVER IMAGINED

We never imagined that we would reach our silver anniversary milestone with Reach Beyond, formerly HCJB and HCJB Global.

<u>We never imagined</u> that we would return to our native formerly communist country as missionaries. We came to the United States as unbelieving refugees after Russian invasion in 1968, and in May 1992 we were back in free Czechoslovakia to serve.

We never imagined that during our lifetime communism would fall. November 1989 was beginning of fall of communism and iron wall. The wall was built as a prison wall; people could not get out. Yes, and it worked absolutely for almost 40 years. In January 1990 Pavel officially left corporate life in Atlantic Richfield and we left Indonesia. In February of 1990 we were already in Ecuador with commitment to return as soon as possible to our native country. In Quito we started under leadership of Ron Cline, had the privilege to know Abe and Marge Van Der Puy, previous president. After Ron and Barb we served under Dave Johnson, Wayne Pederson and now under leadership of the new president Steve Harling. We were introduced to Steve and his wife during a Reach Beyond Conference in Spain. He and Becky have already met with approximately 2/3 of our missionaries, having traveled in Europe, Eurasia, Spain, Ecuador, and the U.S. Most of us remarked about his cross-cultural experience, as he is a good listener, communicator, and sensitive leader. We hope and pray that under his leadership qualities, your prayers and our voice and hands will move us to reach beyond in our respective fields.

<u>We never imagined</u> that we will gain so many wonderful friends and prayer partners for a quarter of a century. Their kindness and love is truly supernatural. Each one of you are part of His glorious patchwork in our lives; it became colorful and beautiful. The Lord blessed us with the most fulfilling years.

PAVEL'S BOOK

At this time we would like to give you an opportunity for one-time special gift toward printing. First let us share how Pavel's first book which actually led to us being in ministry was published. While Pavel wrote the book Battle for the Soul we were wondering how we can finance and publish it without any publisher. Many times Pavel said: "Even if I will have to sell my beloved Volkswagen to pay for the book I will do it." This is exactly what happened. We sold the car and added about \$150 to cover cost of publishing it. The first time we printed it in U.S. 2,000 copies. This is how we started our mission career. This led to publishing magazine with the same name. Now, more than 26 years later, we are still publishing it. Later on we printed 15,000 more in then Czechoslovakia. Our Lord used the book and magazine to save a number of people. All is His work! Now we hope and pray that the new Pavel's book "I Will Not Give My Glory Unto Another" will bring answers to theological questions not too many pastors and churches deal with. The first book was paper back having 208 pages; the new one will be hardcover having close to 400 pages.

THE LAST SHALL BE FIRST

Dear Pavel and Klara

I appreciate your ongoing interest and involvement in Slovak ministry. During past year I informed you about termination of Radio Logos broadcasting. This event caused unexpected reaction from listeners and desire to reinstate broadcasting. One of the brothers showed great interest and he was very enthusiastic and willing to take over the leading responsibility. Our communication was very intensive. We met several times and I shared with the team reason for termination and I explained the terms for reinstatement. It all looked very promising but at the end came to the light reality that his church denomination does not share same vision for this kind of mission outreach. Since there was no support "in-house" and the man had no previous experience with broadcasting plus he is managing his business enterprise, that by itself is time consuming commitment, he felt that he cannot take on himself responsibility like this.

I was trying to encourage him and offered him my help. My plan was to produce programs during one year time without broadcasting and archive new programs while he would get hand on experience. That was our vision for reinstatement of Radio Logos broadcasting. To my surprise after termination of broadcasting group right here in Banska Bystrica showed interest to help to reinstate broadcasting and offered cooperation in new programming. At present time they produce web pages oriented on apologetics. At this time we would like to produce series of apologetic programs and short reflections. Also some teachers from Theological seminary in Banska Bystrica showed interest to continue and expand.

Those are our humble plans in media ministry. I am excited about new opportunities and how the Lord directs our labor. It is not easy to terminate 15 years of merry go round of program production. I feel like entering new life dimension, with gratefulness. I reflect those very intensive years and look forward to direction in time ahead of me. You Klara and Pavel are the ones the Lord miraculously sent my way and influenced my most productive part of life ... My goal is to hand over broadcasting to new generation.

Since we have known Milan for over 20 years we saw many ups and downs. He car-

ried great burden for lost as well as showed exceptional sacrifice. In his case it often looked that he is on the end of those that no one pays attention. As we red Milan's testimonial letter deep understanding of following verses came to our mind:

Mk 10:31. But many that are first shall be last; and the last first.

His accomplishments are absolutely amazing. His faithfulness is exceptional. Most of the time there was no one to encourage him, no thanks, no recognition. I often think that bigger responsibility God entrusts to us, more difficult road leads to the finale. As the church we live, feel and function like children of God, sons, friends, disciples, teachers, saints and priests and volunteers. Yes, we belong to loving father but there is job to be done on the other side of spectrum for His kingdom. Few among His flock become servants, but how many laborers and slaves do you know? Milan is one of them.

Lk 10:2: The harvest indeed is plenteous, but the laborers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he send forth laborers into his harvest.

Now the words like *"behold, there are last which shall be first, and there are first which shall be last (Lk 13:30)* have personal meaning. The highest of all positions is entrusted to His slaves.
